The tour traces the commemorative sites of the Great War, including Vimy Ridge, the battlefields of Pozieres, the famous Windmill site and Mouquet Farm, the Memorial Park at Le Hamel and Wellington Tunnels in Arras.

Travellers will also attend the Anzac Day dawn service, a moving Last Post ceremony at the Menin Gate in Ieper and travel the line to Plug Street along the Messines Ridge.
