guitar virtuoso and composer Tim Andrew performs alongside North Indian tabla master Pranjal Bora, with Alex Borthwick on guitar and Anthony Lindhjem demonstrating harmonic mastery of the six-string bass.

Local

guitar duo Krzysztof and Selepak will kick off the evening entertainment. Both outstanding guitarists by international standards, Krzysztof Piotrowicz is Australia's only performer of the Russian seven-string guitar, and Mardae Selepak one of the nation's finest classical guitar talents.

Together they will perform a range of acoustic guitar arrangements that encapsulate the traditions of Russian, Spanish and South America guitar playing.
