

The Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions Office has today decided to discontinue charges previously laid by ASIC against Shane Heal that were due to be heard in Brisbane's District Court next week. The case, which was listed to start as a trial on Monday May 14, will now no longer proceed.
